#### 0. CALL TO ORDER.

### 2. APPROVAL OF DRAFT MEETING MINUTES (MINUTE 1:54)

**Motion/Action:** Marty Meth made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 21<sup>st</sup> meeting, and Karim Habbab seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### 3. 2050 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) (MINUTE 3:04)

Sandy Shackelford presented the committee with the draft logo for the 2050 LRTP. She continued by explaining the LRTP engagement process and the draft goals and objectives. She explained that the consultant suggested that the goals and objectives be drafted first and then brought to the public for their comments.

Once the goals and objectives are set, she explained that the projects will be prioritized and the public will be able to comment again.

Ms. Shackelford asked the committee for feedback on how to determine whether the public engagement for the LRTP has been successful. The committee members offered numerous suggestions including making sure that all demographics are represented in the survey responses. Donna Chen noted that it will be important to gather this information through the survey questions.

Ms. Shackelford went on to describe the focus groups and asked the committee for feedback on who or what organization might be missing.

Mr. Kondor suggested that the groups should have fewer than 10 members.

The committee discussed the suggested focus groups and why they were chosen. There were numerous suggestions about who else might be included for the focus groups.

Ms. Shackelford defined the goals, objectives, and metrics for the LRTP. She described the current draft goals and objectives and asked the members for feedback. She noted that the public will be offered the opportunity to assist with weighing the priorities.
