

**Resolution Adopting the Charlottesville-Albemarle Metropolitan Planning Organization's  
2050 Long Range Transportation Plan: *MOVING TOWARD 2050***

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) requires that each urbanized area over 50,000 population prepare a Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) to be updated every five years; and,

**WHEREAS**, a Metropolitan Planning Organization has been designated for the Charlottesville-Albemarle Urbanized Area (CA-MPO); and,

**WHEREAS**, the CA-MPO's 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan: *Moving Toward 2050*, addresses future planned transportation projects in the City of Charlottesville and the urbanized planning area of Albemarle County over the next 20 years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the major goal for the CA-MPO's 2050 LRTP is to create and advance a balanced, regional, multimodal transportation network; and,

**WHEREAS**, the CA-MPO led the efforts to complete the 2050 LRTP with a public outreach campaign conducted to solicit input from the community; and,

**WHEREAS**, the CA-MPO recognizes that the SMART SCALE evaluation and funding process will guide major project funding decisions made by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB); and,

**WHEREAS**, the CA-MPO has set targets, as required, for the established national performance measures; and,

**WHEREAS**, the CA-MPO's project and scenario evaluation criteria were chosen to reflect the measures used in SMART SCALE and the national performance measures; and,

**WHEREAS**, this update is required to meet Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements, the deadline for which is the end of May 2024; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Charlottesville-Albemarle Metropolitan Planning Organization approves the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan: *Moving Toward 2050*, pending approval from the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration.
